RESOLUTION NO. R-91-3

A BILL TO CREATE A RESOLUTION ENTITLED:

"A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CENTRALIA, MISSOURI ADOPTING A POLICY RELATING TO CITY PAYMENT FOR WORK PERFORMED ON UTILITY LINES BY PERSONS OTHER THAN CITY EMPLOYEES."

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen desires that the City of Centralia not be responsible for any expenses which are not authorized in advance by proper City employees or officials; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen wishes to clarify and inform its utility customers and local electricians and plumbers of this limitation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Aldermen of the City of Centralia, Missouri hereby adopts the following formal written policy concerning payment for work on utility lines which is performed by persons other than City employees:

CENTRALIA POLICY

NO. 12

CITY PAYMENT FOR UTILITY WORK PERFORMED ON UTILITY LINES
BY PERSONS OTHER THAN CITY EMPLOYEES

In general, the City of Centralia will not pay for or reimburse a customer for any work performed on City water, sewer, or electrical lines by a private electrician, plumber or other person who is not a City employee, including work to clean out City sewer lines, unless it is authorized in advance by the Board of Aldermen or City Administrator by contract or purchase order. Nor will the City pay for or reimburse a customer for plumbing or electrical work performed on a customer's service lines unless it is authorized in advance by the Board of Aldermen or City Administrator by contract or purchase order.

In any instance where payment or reimbursement is authorized, the City shall pay only for labor and equipment use at normal and customary rates and materials at regular retail prices.
