

A BILL TO CREATE A RESOLUTION ENTITLED:

"A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CENTRALIA, MISSOURI ADOPTING A POLICY RELATING TO THE TEMPORARY CLOSING OF PUBLIC STREETS AND ALLEYS."

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Aldermen of the City of Centralia, Missouri, hereby adopts the following formal written policy concerning the temporary closing of public streets and alleys:

CENTRALIA POLICY

NO. 13

TEMPORARY CLOSING OF STREETS AND ALLEYS

1. One or more public streets and alleys may be wholly or partially closed on a temporary basis for gatherings, festivals, block parties, special business promotions, and similar events only by vote of the Board of Aldermen or by written permission of both the Mayor and the Chief of Police. The allowance of the temporary street or alley closure shall specify the time period for the closure.
2. Before the temporary closure of streets and alleys is allowed, the City may require that a written application for such closure be completed and may set such conditions on each closure as it believes are appropriate. In particular, the City may require that the person or firm requesting the closure agree to be responsible for conduct of persons at the event which causes the need for the closure and for the satisfaction of any of the conditions set forth by the City.
3. This policy is not intended to apply to temporary street or alley closures made necessary by maintenance or construction performed by public utilities or governmental agencies. Nor does this policy apply to temporary street or alley closures resulting from fires or other emergency activities.
