Ostmann said she had signed an easement to put the new sidewalks in and they dug up the survey iron on the corner. She stated that she has requested several times that it be put back, but has not gotten a response. She said that since she paid to have the lot surveyed when they bought lot 5 years, it should be replaced. She also said she asked to have an ash tree cut down, and it was cut down. There was another old Ash tree she asked to have cut down but it wasn't done. She said that during the storm in July a large branch from that tree fell and cost \$100 to have it removed. She said she also feels that the sawdust should be cleaned up and grass planted.

Harline said he spoke with MECO Engineering about the survey stake and they have documentation that it was out of the ground before they began the work on the sidewalk and there was also a damaged gas meter in the same area. He said he would try to figure out who was working there, but the damage was not done during the sidewalk project.

Ostmann stated that she thought it was the people who cut down the maple tree moved the survey stake, but still doesn't think it is her responsibility to put it back.

Hearing no further comments, the Comments from Citizens portion of the meeting was closed at 7:06 p.m. by Mayor Grenke.
