- Installed new 2” meter resetter at First Christian Church with a new valve
- Took out fire hydrant at Chris Court that was hit by plow truck and flushed water for service leading to house
- Assisted street department 8 days move snow – 2 people
- Moved water service at 105 S. Allen while customers sewer was being fixed and replaced service with new set up
- Found manhole lid off at Saw mill
- Replaced manhole lid and part of riser on manhole that was broke and taking on water – 860 Doty
- Opened blowdown on primary cell at Water Plant
- Repaired leak on new clamp at 220 Reed
- Met with Insituform on sewer slip-lining to evaluate footage and pricing for next fiscal year
- Repaired broken valve box at Saddle Saloon and located main for GIS mapping purposes
- Located 14 manholes that need to be raised and cut street to raise
- Checked water valves to be raised for GIS
- Walked SW Interceptor to locate manholes covered at sawmill
- Pre-construction meeting on Switzler/Jefferson with engineers and contractors
- Replaced valve box and lid at Burnett / S. Allen
- Pulled pumps at Fountain Road Lift Station 3 times- Checked bar screen daily and cleaned

February 2013 Activity Report

- ✓ Daily trash collection
- ✓ Weekly cardboard and bi-weekly curbside recycling
- ✓ We had one double trash route this month
- ✓ Moved the Santa House from the Friendship Place to 102 Denton
- ✓ Dug out rusted culvert and set 18' of 18" metal culvert across alley on Sneed b/w Columbia and Barr
- ✓ Dug out end of pipe by railroad tracks to help drainage and placed some rip-rap around it
- ✓ Hauled off 4 loads of plastic to Ryan Ent. in Millersburg
- ✓ Raised up yard inlet 749 Tidball for Dustin Daum
- ✓ Painted 2 parking spots on Sneed next to the city square yellow
- ✓ Added some rock and smoothed up several alleys
- ✓ Cleaned up the shop and office
- ✓ Emptied and washed out both spreaders and sprayed conveyor chains
- ✓ Piled brush at drop site several times
- ✓ Pushed the brush pit, piled compost and dirt at the landfill
- ✓ Bladed the landfill roads, s. Columbia, Randolph, and park road
- ✓ Hauled and spread a load of rock on tear drop at the park
- ✓ Piled and stirred up the salt and sand piles
- ✓ Worked on drainage around town
- ✓ Repaired lights on spreader on #77
- ✓ Repaired hoist cable in dump truck #76
- ✓ Cleaned 2 pickups, and 3 dump trucks
- ✓ Pumped water out of storm sewer under Chance's parking lot and went inside and inspected it
- ✓ Dug out ditch by Stowers lot on Jefferson

- ✓ Spent several days repairing the dozer shed at the landfill (roof, walls, etc.), also built berm to divert water from running in shed and placed several loads of rip in and in front of shed
- ✓ Dug out and set 36' of 12" metal culvert across the landfill road near the front gate
- ✓ Swept streets
- ✓ Made street signs
- ✓ Relocated 4 signs to light poles and removed posts on n. Allen
- ✓ Replaced 1 faded railroad sign, 6 faded stop signs, re-installed no parking sign on Allen b/w the tracks, and straightened lots of signs
- ✓ Assembled and delivered 1 trash cart
- ✓ Replaced all of the bolts in one of the snow plows
- ✓ Put new cutting edges on the grader and put tire chains on it
- ✓ Cleaned and greased the backhoe and loader
- ✓ Loaded spread with material, installed plows and got all equipment ready to go
- ✓ Spent 9 days this month plowing, spreading material, and hauling off snow
