May 2013 Activity Report

- # Weekly cardboard and bi-weekly curbside recycling routes
- # Had one trash truck destroyed by fire and the other one damaged
- # Daynes Waste Disposal has been helping us out with trash collection until we get a trash truck back
- # Dug out and patched back utility cuts: 2 on Allen st., 1 on Burnett st., and put extra in rut on landfill road
- # Hauled off 3 loads of plastic to Ryan Ent. in Millersburg
- # Removed and replaced broken ADA mat on sidewalk along s. Columbia st.
- # Hauled off 2 loads of recycling to Civic Recycling in Columbia
- # Added rock and smoothed up lots of shoulders and alleys
- # Met with homeowner at 720 s Rollins st. about their culvert and ditch
- # Took out loaner dumpsters several times this month
- # Cleaned up the street barn
- # Swept all of the curbed streets around town
- # Spent several days hauling off brush at the drop off site to the landfill
- # Assembled and delivered 5 trash cart
- # Spent 4 days digging out and formed and poured 220' of sidewalk, and stripped forms, saw cut, backfilled and seeded and strawed along the east side of the city square
- # Met with DNR and inspected old landfill on Fountain rd
- # Patched potholes
- # Replaced leaking hyd hose, and replaced curb broom on the street sweeper
- # Spent 3 days painting the walls at 105 Allen, still need to finish the second coat
- # Mowed and weedeated the whole town
- # Dug and set 52' of 10" metal culvert in the alley behind 816 Booth for Larry Spears for a driveway
- # Spent several days working on drainage around town
- # Hauled almost 100 barricades to downtown for the Anchor Festival
- # Hauled off brush around town
- # Cut out broken section of curb on Emerald ct. and formed and poured it
- # Trimmed lots of tree limbs hanging over sidewalks and blocking signs
- # Did lots of locates this month
- # Sign work:
 - Replaced faded stop sign and missing street sign at Cox/Sappington
 - Straightened lots of signs
 - Replaced and relocated 4 crosswalk signs on Jefferson by High school and added arrows and ahead sign to them
 - Replaced street sign at Jefferson/Rodemyre and put on light pole and removed old post
 - Replaced faded speed limit and no parking on Adams
- # Switzler Street Project:
 - Dug and set 24' of 18" concrete pipe
 - Dug and set 20' of 15" plastic pipe
 - Dug and set 30' of 18" plastic pipe
 - Poured floors for inlet boxes
 - Set and poured 2 inlet boxes

May 2013

- Moved water service at 501 E. Switzler for upcoming street project
- Moved water service at 601 E. Switzler for street job
- Moved water service at 617 E. Switzler for street job
- Moved water service at 701 E. Switzler for street job
- Removed old East Side Auto (Brooks property) water service
- Pulled Fountain Road Lift station pumps twice
- Weeded around overland flow pipes – all three cells
- Sprayed around all pipes at overland flow fields
- Met with Herndon about lift station pumps and bar screens – made two new, with tighter baskets
- Checked leak at 408 Pratt – residents
- Called about leak at Tidball's trailer court – turned out to be old drain full from rain water
- Called about leak at Bruton / Bruton – turned out to be leak and full storm sewer
- Call in to shut off water at 705 Southland due to leak
- Dirt work at various dig sites
- Moved water service out of drive to stop meter problems and damage
- Met with resident at 441 S. Jefferson about usage and billing
- Mowed at lagoons
- Worked with Chance Company to avoid conflicts with fiber boring to all Plants
- Flushed all fire hydrants
- Call in to shut off water at #7 Tidballs due to leak
- Repaired leak at 313 Country Club Dr. on meter yoke
- Raised and sealed leaking manhole at Hwy. 22 / Hobby Horse
- Raised manhole to grade along Hwy. 22 in front of Hobby Horse
- Assisted street department with flushing storm sewers
- Call in to 1219 Remington about meter jar lid coming off easily Replaced 3 broken valve boxes and lids from mowers
- 11 Disconnects for nonpayment
- 84 meters did not read due to rainfall amounts
- Pulled overland flow pump due to electric short (minus 1 racoon) and took to S&S Electric in Mexico
