ACTIVITY REPORT
WATER DEPARTMENT
JUNE 2013

- Moved three fire hydrants back off Switzler for new street improvements
- Moved 5 water services and meter jars back to be clear of sidewalks on Switzler
- Added two water and sewer services on Switzler at 507 and 701 for future use
- Replaced leaking valve at Switzler / Lee street
- Met with Midland GIS and assisted where needed on mapping system
- Assisted Water District #10 in shutting off water on leak at Sunnydale
- Assisted Lot # 61 at Tidball's shut off water due to leak
- Moved rip-rap along discharge structure at N.E. Lagoon to stop erosion
- Hauled clay to low spot on primary basin to build up
- Called out to 614 Rodemeyer to assist in fixing leak
- Assisted Insituform with sewer lining questions
- Mowed at overland flow fields and sprayed
- Worked with Chance boring crew to avoid conflicts with utilities
- Followed up on sewer issue at 404 Bradford to make sure it was properly fixed
- Dirt work at several locations from previous dig sites
- Assisted electric department with installing relay at N.E. Pump house to stop surges
- Replaced manhole frame and lid at Rt. CC
- Took out old ¾" service and changed to 1" at Pratt / E. Switzler – Brooks
- Called in to shut off water at 620 Booth

JULY 2013 ACTIVITY REPORT**

1. Hauled brush/yard waste as necessary
2. Repaired streetlights – Lakeview/Ash, Meadowlark Lane, Orchard/Ivy, South/Maple
3. Repaired security lights – 716 Head St.
4. Trimmed trees for line clearance – 633 Meadowlark Lane, Lakeview/Hawthorn
5. Trimmed trees for street clearance – E. Sims, W. Southgate, N. Jefferson/Switzler
6. Removed trees –
7. Replaced street light pole knocked down by vehicle along west side of City Square
8. CHS/Rollins Project – trenched, laid 2” & 4” conduit, CATV, Phone, cut down tree in trench path
9. Repaired outlet at City Pool storage building
10. CHS/Rollins Project – trenched, laid 4” pipe to meter location for CHS football field & removed stump
11. 605 Pool St – connected temporary service
12. CHS/Rollins Project – installed transformer pads
13. Pole 5178 – picked up old pole along N Jefferson north of Wigham, stripped equipment off of pole, hauled away to scrap pole pile, loaded new pole & delivered to site
14. Pole 5178 – Replaced pole along N. Jefferson struck down by grain truck on 7/2/13
15. Trenched and laid pipe across Kelli Court (SW Country Subdivision)
16. CHS/Rollins project – pulled three phase UG primary from Cox to sector cabinet, from sector cabinet to sector cabinet, from sector cabinet to meter cabinet
17. Rollins/Singleton street light – moved foundation, fit conduit, pulled wire, reinstalled street light
18. CHS/Rollins project – finished riser pipes at Gano Chance pole, blew all remaining strings, pulled in rope from sector cabinet to Gano Chance riser pole
19. CHS/Rollins project – removed cutouts at Gano Chance riser pole, pulled three phase UG primary from Gano Chance to sector cabinet and all single phase runs between transformers – total #2 primary URD wire pulled = 7235’
20. Connected temporary services – 2 @ Cobblestone, 1 @ Mystic Ridge
21. CHS/Rollins Project – switched feed of circuit, terminated primary @ Cox St.
22. CHS/Rollins project – Installed 4-way junctions in 3-phase sector cabinets, started terminating elbows, started trenching and installing conduit for services to houses(102 Cox)
23. CHS/Rollins project – Trenched & installed conduit for service at 714 S. Rollins, terminated elbows @ sector cabinet
24. CHS/Rollins project – Trenched & installed conduit for service at 716 S. Rollins

STREET & SANITATION DEPARTMENT

Activity Report for July 2013

- ♠ Dayne's waste Disposal help with trash collection for the first week of the month
- ♠ Weekly cardboard recycling, and bi-weekly curbside recycling routes
- ♠ Received our new trash truck and put it into service
- ♠ Stripped forms, backfilled, and poured floors in 3 inlets on Switzler Street Project
- ♠ Dug out and added 12' of 10" metal culvert to driveway at 806 s. Rollins for the homeowner
- ♠ Assembled and delivered 10 trash carts to city residents
- ♠ Assisted water dept. with leak on s. Rollins
- ♠ Built shoulder in front of 612 e. Booth for homeowner
- ♠ Took out loaner dumpsters several times this month
- ♠ Had one double trash route this month
- ♠ Spent a couple days spraying weeds along streets and curbs
- ♠ Hauled off brush from drop site to the landfill several times this month
- ♠ Hauled off 4 loads of plastic to Ryan Ent. in Millerburg
- ♠ Mowed ditches around town
- ♠ Did lots of locates this month
- ♠ Trimmed tree limbs blocking street signs
- ♠ Cleaned up shop and lot
- ♠ Pushed the brush pit at the landfill
- ♠ Repaired hydraulic leak, tightened the tracks, and greased the dozer
- ♠ Bladed several alleys, Randolph, and the landfill roads
- ♠ Repaired street sign at Emerald and Jefferson that got hit and knocked down
- ♠ Helped Special Road District remove and replace 3 culverts, 2- 40' x 24" plastic pipes, and 1 – 30' x 12" metal culvert
- ♠ Patched potholes
- ♠ Spent a couple days painting crosswalks and parking lines
- ♠ Loaded several trucks with mulch
- ♠ Dug out and then cut out and installed 12" x 10" tee in storm sewer on e. Gano to drain waterhole
- ♠ Added rock and smoothed up several shoulders and alleys
- ♠ Hauled off 2 loads of recycling to Civic Recycling in Columbia
- ♠ Tore out and formed and poured 63' of sidewalk on s. Allen
- ♠ Tore out sidewalk and curb at ne corner of city square, extended the storm sewer and built new inlet box, and formed and poured new curb
- ♠ Helped Special Road District mix up a batch of cold mix asphalt
- ♠ Cut out and filled in hole that had developed under Lakeview
- ♠ Swept streets
- ♠ Cleaned up backhoe, and the pickup
- ♠ Tore out sidewalk at 414 s. Allen for homeowner
- ♠ Prepped parking area on Rollins in front of Elementary school for wedging
- ♠ Wedged Rollins by Elementary School, 2 areas at Sneed and Collier, 3 areas in city parking lot on Jefferson, 2 areas on Poage, and 1 area on North
