**ACTIVITY REPORT
WATER DEPARTMENT
OCTOBER 2013**

- Adjusted manholes and valves to final grade on Switzler before concrete work
- Stayed with pavers on Switzler throughout putting concrete to make sure valves and manholes were not covered
- Fixed leak on sewer main from City Hall in alley by Police Station
- Replaced bad bolts on meter at Stonecrest to fix leak
- Removed old service in sidewalk at First Christian Church and removed from water main
- Checked water taste and odor concerns at 314 E. Lakeview – ok
- Made water tap at 822 E. Head
- Located all manholes at Saw Mill and brought up to grade
- Replaced broken valve box at Green Thumb Nursery
- Raised three meter jars to grade on Switzler and moved one future service back on property
- Met with Boone Electric on power failure and meter issue at the NE Lagoon pump house
- Assisted resident at 600 block with leak repairs – call in
- Seeded and straw work at 4 previous dig locations
- Went over latest GIS maps and made corrections
- Assisted street department with sidewalk removal at First Christian Church
- Raised meter jar to grade at 923 Mystic and lowered valve box
- Mowed at both lagoons and lift stations
- Changed broken meter jar at 527 Orchard
- Met with Chance Company about fence installation off Howard Burton to avoid utility conflicts
- Winterized pump houses and tower pits
- Checked for blockage in sewer main at 507 Switzler – ok. Inspected repairs from Brown’s Plumbing to avoid street cuts
- Met with Curt Kelly at new LaCrosse Lumber location on water connections and sewer tie-in
- Reset manhole frame and lid behind Centralia Clinic that had been hit
- Reset manhole frame and lid off Randolph Road that was knocked off
- Lowered valve boxes at Forrest Chevrolet
- Call out to 1213 Remington to shut off water due to leak
- Call out to 101 Sunset to check for sewer blockage – ok
- Call in to assist resident at Ivy Lane on water service repair
- Call in to Water Plant on alarm – high clearwell
- 6 Disconnects for non-payment
- 30 readings for meter issues

STREET and SANITATION DEPARTMENT

Activity Report for October 2013

- Daily trash collection
- Weekly cardboard and bi-weekly curbside recycling
- Took out loaner dumpsters several times this month
- Dug out and patched back street cuts : 1 on Pool, 1 on Mayes Meadows, 1 on Fairview, 1 on Lakeview, 1 on North, 1 on Tidball, 1 on Coulter, 1 on Rollins, 1 in alley behind Kinkeads, 1 on Hulen, 1 on Sunset, 1 on Bryson, bad area on Clayton, 2 bad areas on Stone, and 1 bad area on Brick
- Assembled and delivered 4 trash carts to city residents
- Replaced post and speed limit sign on Gano that was run over
- Stripped forms and poured floors inside of 2 inlets on Switzler project
- Did some ditch cleaning on Booth, and on Early
- Placed some rip rap around several culverts to stop erosion
- Replaced both batteries in old trash truck
- Swept streets
- Spent a few days trimming tree limbs hanging over sidewalks and blocking signs
- Had lots of locates this month
- Went and got load of cold mix and spent several days patching potholes
- Hauled 10 inlet grates to Switzler for the contractor
- Hauled in 2 stacks of road steel from the landfill to Switzler for the contractor
- Mowed ditches around town
- Did some weedeating around town
- Hauled lots of barricades to the city square for the BBQ contest, and then hauled back and put in the shop when over
- Replaced broken grate on Adams st
- Helped the sewer dept. get 5 manholes on Switzler to grade
- Hauled off 3 loads of recycling to Civic Recycling in Columbia
- Spent 2 days and tore out sidewalk on Rollins beside the First Christian Church
- Replaced street sign bracket on street light at Lakeview and Rollins
- Hauled off brush from drop site to the landfill
- Replaced post on street sign at Hwy 22 and Country Club dr that was run over
- Had several meetings on Switzler Project
- Spent 5 days on Switzler watching and assisting contractor with final prep and pouring of street
- Changed 25 mph to 15 mph on Remington
- Cut off 4 inlets on Switzler Project and set grates
- Replaced pole on stop sign at Jefferson and Wigham that was run over
- Dug out and set 30' of 10" plastic pipe and cleaned the ditch at 607 Pool
- Hauled off 4 loads of plastic to Ryan Ent. in Millersburg
- Cleaned up the shop
- Worked on drainage around town
- Did maintenance on the loader and the trash truck

4. Trimmed trees - WSS SW circuit, Hickman/Railroad area, line clearance in alley between Collier/Rollins from Sneed to Barnes, line clearance in alley adjacent to IC Billiards, 707 Green – trimmed limbs away from service drop, Collier/Railroad main circuit,
5. Total monthly readings – 63
6. Re-reads - 15
7. Total monthly locates – 72
8. CHS/Rollins Project – wrecked out remaining two spans and switches near 902 S. Rollins, pulled 3 poles, dressed up trench, pulled poles, pulled last two remaining poles, hauled to landfill
9. Transferred services at Albert's Shoe Shop and Tangles Salon to new pole
10. Loaded Anchor Fest/BBQ Contest temporary outlet boxes, took them to shop and marked outlets, touched up paint, & made any necessary repairs
11. Replaced pole at Bruton/Hickman
12. Set/Removed temp boxes for BBQ fest
13. Replaced pole @ old landfill site, replaced anchor
14. Assisted Sewer Department with repair in alley next to Centralia Police Department
15. 324 S Collier – replace pole 6304
16. 214 S Rollins – added pole
17. Miles/Leabrook easement – added grass seed to area adjacent to ditch and where underground was installed
18. 605-619 Pool project – designed and staked for pole replacements
19. 1017 Hampton – pulled wire and connected new UG service, disconnected temporary service
20. Moved and replaced street light pole along Hwy 22 at Dollar General Store driveway, pulled three spans wire and made connections
21. 500 block of S Collier St - Replaced HPS light bulbs with LED light bulbs adjacent to Chance Elementary School-used five Light Efficient Design, a division of TADD, LLC post top LED-8024-DL 45 W bulbs, Day light 5700K, 360 degree beam, up to 50,000 hour life, 85-277V, 5 yr. limited warranty
22. 607 Pool – connected temporary service
23. 923 Mystic Dr – pulled wire, connected new UG service
24. 927 Windset – pulled wire, connected new UG service
25. Lacrosse/State Farm – finished 4" conduit at pole, blew string in, pulled two light poles, hauled to old pole pile, pulled in #2 underground primary wire from riser pole to sector cabinet, Installed 4-way junctions, elbow arresters, and insulated bushing caps in sector cabinet, loaded cabinet and transformer, installed both on pads @ job site, installed 3-phase equipment mount, CO's, and LA's on pole, started terminating UG primary wire, finished terminations at pole, terminated elbows at sector cabinet and single phase transformer, connected and energized overhead lines along Hwy 22 from old MoDot shed to dead end at Lacrosse
26. 229 W. Barnes (FCC) – moved one street light foundation, installed another, installed 160 feet of 1 ½" PVC conduit, installed street light foundation near corner of Rollins/Barnes, finished installing conduit pipe,

backfilled trench with rock, Put together two decorative street lights for new FCC sidewalk, pulled wire, made connections, installed 3 street lights

27. 822 E Head St – connected temporary service

28. KCS Railroad – connected new overhead service @ Fullenwider St for signal power, strung 120' of #4 triplex, made connections, energized

29. 821 Chris Court – disconnected temporary and connected permanent service

30. 214 S. Rollins – Pulled wire and connected new UG service

31. Repaired light on Water Plant

32. Assisted Sewer Department with pump at Fountain Road Lift Station

33. 570 W Tidball – trimmed limb away from service line
