## ***November 2014 Activity Report***


1. Daily trash collection
2. Weekly cardboard and bi-weekly curbside recycling routes
3. We had 2 double trash routes this month
4. Hauled off 4 loads of plastic to Ryan Ent. in Millersburg
5. Assembled and delivered 4 trash carts to city residents
6. Got 4 pallets of calcium chloride and put into shed
7. Greased and cleaned the backhoe and the loader
8. Did some ditch cleaning on Cook, Richey, and Leach
9. Had 23 locates this month
10. Spent 3 days working on the Miles street ditch, cut out hauled off lots of brush and trees, dug out and widen and straightened out the ditch, placed several truckloads of rip-rap to help control erosion
11. Went and got a load of cold mix and patched potholes
12. Spent several days hauling off brush and leaves from the drop off site to the brush pit at the landfill
13. Attended a safety meeting at the Boone County Fairgrounds
14. Dug out and set 20ft of 12in plastic pipe for a new driveway on Walnut st. and cleaned out the ditches
15. Installed new post for stop sign at Jefferson and Southgate that was knocked down
16. Spent several days hauling off debris pile at the landfill to a pond north of town
17. Straightened several signs
18. Loaded trailer with mulch for the park dept.
19. Installed new post and put stop sign at Allen and Switzler that was knocked down
20. Dug out and set 64ft of 10in plastic pipe, 2 inlets, and connected sump pump and gutter drains to storm sewer, and hauled in 2 loads of dirt to cover up in front of 910 s. Rollins for the homeowner
21. Had all of the fire extinguishers inspected by Fire Safety
22. Cleaned and straightened up work truck
23. Added rock and smoothed driveway at the cemetery
24. Welded hooks on bed for tarp straps, and repaired the tailgate chain hooks on one of the dump trucks
25. Hauled off 1 load of recycling to Civic Recycling in Columbia

**Re: Solid Waste Rates**



During the discussion on Solid Waste on Saturday, November 22<sup>nd</sup> we discussed the need to raise the rate for trash collection. The City of Columbia raised their rates to \$41.00/ton as of the start of their fiscal year. I have spoken with the Solid Waste Utility Manager Cynthia Mitchell and Public Works Director John Glascock and any increases in the gate rate would be next October at the soonest, but they are far from deciding when the next increase would come. They are closer and less expensive than Love's Transfer Station in Audrain County (Scott's Corner).

We are beginning to see the amount of garbage collected trend up with the economy, but it is not yet at pre-2007 levels. The cost of disposal is, of course, the amount of trash, times the gate rate plus the operating costs for the trucks. The revenues are fixed based on the cost per customer.



There is little chance of diverting sufficient garbage by recycling to offset this increase as we diver about 20 tons per year. Therefore we probably will need to increase rates by one dollar per month to offset the additional cost of the Columbia gate rate.

Our rates would not be out of line with area costs, but we would be on the higher end. A chart is included on the next page.
