## Electric Department Activity Report November 2017

- Cards- 41

- Rereads- 25
- Installed new underground in the 900 block of South Central Street.
- Repaired street lights Richey and Rocky, Windset and Hampton, 605 North Columbia Street, Highway 22 and Cook and two lights at Burkhardt Substation.
- Trimmed trees at 703 Porter Street, alley between Allen and Rollins, Cox Street from Pool Street to Allen Street, alley from Walnut Street to Maple Street, 720 East Rodemeyer, at Mitchell and Clayton Street, removed one at 121 North Hickman Street, removed two trees at 715 South Rollins, 1001 East Booth and 227 South Barr Street, dropped service drop at 230 South Rollins for tree trimmer.
- Installed new services at 522 West Southgate, 1210 Fairway Drive and 901 East Southland.
- Installed temporary electric at 715,706,805 Jason Court, 710 South Street and 623 South Central Street.
- Had one outage at 118 East Railroad Street - Landlord had a meter base issue.

## **Activity Report for November 2017**

1. Collected and bailed cardboard recycling from businesses 3 times a week
2. Spent 7 days this month hauling leaves and brush off from drop off site out to the old landfill site
3. Spent 2 days working with Special Road District and hauled 27 loads of cinders from City of Columbia power plant out to the old city landfill area where we piled up for use during the winter
4. Pushed the brush pit at the landfill with the dozer
5. Did 36 locates this month
6. Spent several days sweeping streets around town (trying to clean up leaves)
7. Spent a few days and finished up mowing around town for the year
8. Hauled 20 barricades up to the Narraganset bldg. and blacked off around it
9. Cut off the ends of 2 culverts that had been damaged
10. Spent a few days piling, and cleaning out the trash on the compost, and then moved other compost pile over to make more room
11. Hauled off 2 loads of plastic and 3 loads of recycling to City of Columbia recycling facility
12. Picked up recycling at all of the schools, city hall, and the Guard office
13. Cleaned up around the shop
14. Repaired sign at city parking lot on Allen st
15. Spent several days tearing down old Whistler house, getting the lot cleaned up, capping the sewer and seeding the lot at Collier and Railroad
16. Hauled off debris pile at the street barn out to the old landfill area
17. Met Gary Dorr with 5 Oaks Construction to discuss drainage and culverts
18. Rented tractor and grade-all from Rodgers Rental and spent a couple days working on alleys and cemetery roads
19. Hauled off 4 loads of concrete out to farmer outside of town
20. Attended bid opening for the new recycling container
21. Shot grade on n. Allen st and met with Gary Dorr
22. Worked on shoulder on Collier st.
23. Dug out and poured concrete back to repair street cuts on Booth, Rodney Griffin, Denton, Jefferson, and on Wright ct.
24. Dug out a 16ft x 10in metal culvert and relocated for new house on s. Central for Ben Randolph
25. Got all of the fire extinguishers out and had Fire Safety check all of them
26. Took dump truck #76 to Meyers to get parking brake switch replaced and short in the wiring harness fixed
27. Moved the Santa House from out at the old landfill to the City Square
28. Took dump truck #77 to Viking-Cives Midwest in Oak Grove to have the new snowplow mounted
29. Repaired speed limit sign on Railroad st.
30. Met with Lee England and he has gotten started on burning the brush pit at the landfill
31. Met with Darren Adams on storm sewer on Central st.
32. Met with Matt and discussed up coming projects, and paving for next year

- Flushed all fire hydrants for fall
- Worked on six fire hydrants – oil and exercised
- Assisted Visu-Sewer where needed with sewer lining on Lakeview
- Replaced water meter service at 603 N. Barr
- Replaced water meter service at 509 Central
- Replaced water meter service at 725 S. Central
- Raised manhole to grade on Jason Court to meet finished yard grade
- Raised meter jar to grade at Emerald Drive to meet sod level
- Raised valve lids to meet sod level at 708 Emerald Drive
- Replaced broken meter jar lid and raised to final grade at 801 Shawn Ct.
- Used sewer machine to open blockage in overflow pipe at lime ponds
