Activity Report for January 2024

- Did 35 locates this month
- Patched several potholes
- Attended weekly dept. head meetings
- Attended city council meeting on 1/15/2024
- Spent several days cleaning and organizing the street barn and storage shed
- Hauled and spread several loads of rock on Rowland and bladed
- Built railing for sidewalk on Booth St.
- Loaded scrap dumpster with old appliances
- Met with Jon Smith about driveway and drainage at new house on s. Central
- Equipment maintenance:
 - Serviced and made some repairs to the mower tractor
 - Cleaned and maintenance equipment
- Snow removal:
 - Checked out and prepped all of the equipment several times
 - Replaced skids and rubber cutting edge on the snow pusher
 - Spent 9 days plowing and spreading materials
 - Spent a couple days hauling off snow piles downtown
 - Emptied and washed spreaders and trucks
 - Cleaned up trash in salt shed and moved pallets of calcium around
- Drainage work:
 - Dug out 2 old pipes at alley on Switzler and set 20ft of 15in plastic culvert, 1 tee, 20ft of 10in plastic. Then set 20ft of 15in plastic culvert for a new driveway for Delwyn Duncan and cleaned the ditch
 - Checked and worked on drainage around town
 - Shot grade on several ditches

- Started working with Bartlett & West on putting together an installation bid packet for the new Chemco slaker.
- After speaking to Blake with Bartlett & West, the plan as of today is to advertise the installation of the Chemco Slaker in March. We will receive bids in April, and then award the contractor in April. Next the plan is to get the contract done in mid-May, and have a preconstruction meeting at the end of May before the arrival of the equipment June 17th.
