

Centralia Park Board Meeting Minutes (unapproved)

Tuesday, May 15, 2018

Centralia Municipal Pool 12:00 PM

Park Board Members Present: Mike Kinkead, Richard Dickerson, Harold Beasley, Mandi Barnes, Bev Reynolds, Harold Ward, JoDean Newsted, and Dale Davidson.

Also Present: Erle Bennett-Park Director, Andrea Owens-Secretary, Brady Dopler-Activities Director, Chandler Blackwell-Intern, and Matt Harline-City Administrator.

Meeting was called to order at 12:07 p.m. by Park Board President, Mike Kinkead.

The Minutes from April 17, 2018 was approved by consent.

The Treasurer's Report was approved by consent.

The City Administrator explained that the City is moving forward with the Energy Efficient Program, and has \$50,000 worth of projects for the Recreation Center. Richard Dickerson moved with a second from Harold Beasley to implement the Energy Efficient Program on a 15 year contract, at no initial cost to the Recreation Center, contingent upon the stratification fans in the gymnasium being able to be covered with cages. Motion passed unanimously.

Park

The Park Director presented a calendar of events to the Park Board:

- ◆ Free concerts will be held every Thursday night in June at the City Square from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.
- ◆ Two free movies will be shown at City Park –June 8th- Jumanji and July 27th –Star Wars.
- ◆ Home Run Derby and Pitch, Hit, and Run Events were held past two Saturdays, and had approximately 20 kids participating in each event.
- ◆ A second Umpire training will be held on Wednesday, May 23, 2018 at Bicentennial Park at 9:00 a.m.

The following is a list of projects going on in the Parks:

- ◆ Trash cans are being updated with lids.
- ◆ Ball fields and City Square are in process of being fertilized.
- ◆ All parks have been sprayed for weeds.
- ◆ The address signs are being installed at shelters and parks.
- ◆ The Garden Club is assisting the Park Dept. in the purchase of the hanging flower baskets for the City Square and JayCee Park.
- ◆ Four Ash trees will be removed from the City Square, and replaced with new trees.
- ◆ Two rotten posts at JayCee Park Shelter will be replaced.
- ◆ All signage in the parks are in process of being repainted.
- ◆ A bench with "Centralia Panthers" has been made out of a cherry tree that was removed 2 years ago, and will be placed between the South and North Shelter area.
- ◆ Renovations to the bathrooms at City Park are almost completed.
- ◆ Landscaping will be completed at the North Shelter of City Park.
- ◆ A Memorial Tree has been ordered for Heather Morris and will be planted by the West field at Bicentennial Park.

JoDean made a motion with a second from Bev Reynolds to begin a Pumpkin Fall Festival this year on October 20, 2018 that will include decorated pumpkins at the City Square, games, and face painting. Motion passed unanimously. Details of event will be announced at a later date.

Recreation Center

It was reported that the Rec Center currently has 3,037 members. Last month the membership was 3,047, and last year the membership was 2,948.

Classes will continue through the summer, but on a lighter schedule:

- Morning Mix, Seniors in Shape, and 6 p.m. Aerobics will continue on a regular basis
- 5 AM classes are done until the fall.
- Mom's Fit will not resume at this time.
- There will be a June session of Yoga.
- A Zumba class will be added to summer schedule.

Class forms and schedules will be available at the front desk of the Recreation Center the end of May.

The Park Director reported that two new treadmills have been installed in the Fitness Center to replace the 2013 models.

The new ADA automatic doors have been installed and wired at the Recreation Center and are in working order.

The Park Director reported that the open Volleyball night started May 14th and had 6 participants; and that Pickle ball continues strongly on Monday through Thursdays from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Pool

The Pool opens May 28, 2018, and the returning guards will be getting re-certified on May 21, and May 22, 2018. The local police and EMT's will be providing additional training skills in order to develop skills to handle a variety of situations.

The Park Director discussed the many events planned at the Pool this summer: See the attached Pool information sheet for details.

Items Which May Arise

Discussion was held regarding the need for a Park on the Northeast side of town by the Subway and Trailer Court area. Information will be gathered and revisited at a later date.

Bev Reynolds made a motion with a second from Harold Ward to hire a new photographer for \$500 to take pictures throughout the Parks, Pool, and Rec in order to update photos for pamphlets, facebook, and websites. Motion passed unanimously.

Discussion was held regarding the Mayor appointing a new Park Board Member in June of 2018.

By unanimous consent, the Park Board agreed to rename the Recreation Center the "Enlow Recreation Center" in memory of the late Jim and Janey Enlow. The City Administrator will present to the City Council meeting at next meeting.

Next regularly scheduled meeting will be held on Tuesday, June 19, 2018 at 12:00 p.m.

Meeting adjourned at 1:23 p.m.
