

Centralia Park Board Meeting Minutes (unapproved)  
Tuesday, November 13, 2018  
Centralia Recreation Center  
12:00 PM

**Park Board Members Present:** Mike Kinkead, Richard Dickerson, Mandi Barnes, Bev Reynolds, Phil Hulén, and Harold Beasley.

**Also Present:** Erle Bennett-Park Director, Andrea Owens-Secretary.

Meeting was called to order at 12:07 p.m. by Park Board President, Mike Kinkead.

The Minutes from October 16, 2018 were approved by consent.

The Treasurer's Report was not ready at this time.

**Park**

The Park Director reported that the concrete and posts for the dug outs are in at the South Field, and the fencing will be increased from 8 feet to 20 feet.

The Park Director presented bids for new playground equipment from Little Tykes, Fry and Associates, Athco, and Miracle. Richard Dickerson made a motion with a second from Harold Beasley to accept the Miracle Playground bid of \$32,000 to be installed at the South field play area. Motion passed unanimously.

The Park Board discussed declaring the current South field playground as surplus property at the next meeting.

The Park Director reported that the cost of additional expenditure estimates for capital improvements are as follows:

- East Field Bathroom \$20,000
- Dug outs and Fencing at South Field \$19,000
- New playground at South field \$43,000

**East Annex**

The Park Director reported that Dormakabba and Alarm Communication Center (ACC) installed the mechanisms for key fob entry into the East Annex building. ACC is still in the process of the configuring the virtual pad that will be used for entry.

The Park Director reported that he will be researching upgrading the camera system at the East Annex and the Recreation Center.

The Park Director reported that the turf and batting mats are in at the East Annex and teams have started scheduling practices for January and February 2019.

Harold Beasley made a motion with a second from Richard Dickerson to extend the lease for ACT (Alternative Community Training) for \$600.00 a month for six months. Motion passed unanimously.

**Recreation Center**

It was reported that the Rec Center currently has 2,977 members. Last month the membership was 2,969, and last year the membership was 2,901. The Rec Center currently has 74 Silver Sneaker participants enrolled.

Regular scheduled classes of Morning Mix, Seniors in Shape, 6 PM Aerobics, and TTH Yoga and Monday night Zumba will continue for the first three weeks of December. On Thursday January 3<sup>rd</sup> at 6:00 p.m. there will be a "kick off" free 30 minute demonstrations of classes that will be offered.

The Park Director reported that three treadmills need to be repaired with new decks and new belts, or replaced completely. A vote will be taken at the next meeting.

5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade Youth Basketball has begun practices in half of the gymnasium at the Rec Center on Monday through Thursday evenings. Games will be played on Saturdays December 1, 8, 15, and 29<sup>th</sup>. The 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade Youth Basketball League will be held in January and February 2019.

### **Pool**

Richard Dickerson made a motion with a second from Bev Reynolds to adopt the proposed 2019 Pool Calendar (see attached). Motion passed unanimously.

The Park Director reported that the lights have been delivered and waiting on a ring for installation.

The Park Director reported that the cost to replace the two valves will be \$5,000 each, so the Park Director is going to obtain a second opinion.

A Triathlon has been scheduled for June 22, 2019. Details to be released at a later date.

### **Items Which May Arise**

Discussion was held about the wage scale and minimum wage workers regarding possible changes that will be implemented in 2019. No decision made at this time.

Discussion was held regarding smoking in the Parks. To be revisited at a later date.

Discussion was held regarding the possibility of increasing the Recreation Center membership dues in the next year or two.

Next regularly scheduled meeting will be held on either Tuesday December 4, 2018 or Tuesday December 11<sup>th</sup> 2018.

Meeting adjourned at 1:18 p.m.

### Swimming Pool Hours

- Sunday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday: 1:00 – 6:00 p.m.
- Monday and Friday: 1:00 to 7:00 p.m.

### Splash Pad Hours - Open Daily Weather Permitting

- May 17 - September 30 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Splash pad is part of the pool fees DURING pool hours.
- Splash pad is FREE before and after pool hours.
